1) FY2017 Project Planning Discussion

The purpose was to identify potential projects for the upcoming FY17 budget discussion. The committee created the following list of ideas:

A. <u>Destination Downtown Banners:</u>

*The committee would like to keep the different district designations however; they would like to explore changing out the signage to match the new branding. *Investigate whether the existing signage can be modified or if new signage will be needed.

*Determine potential design and construction costs.

B. Kiosks:

*Would like to explore placing a kiosk in front of All-American Insurance and revisit the idea with the Boys and Girls Club.

*Follow up with the MDBA on the timing of the new list of businesses.

*Recreating the panels [with the business listings] with the new branding.

C. <u>Directional Signage:</u>

*Revisit the design with the new branding.

*If pictures are to be included, include all three; or perhaps just the black square of the logo.

- D. <u>Overhead Entrance Signage:</u> *Focus for FY17 should be on design concepts and continue to save for this project.
- E. <u>Other Entrance Signage Opportunities Directing Downtown:</u>
 *The Human Bean at the SW corner of Meridian Road and Cherry Lane.
 - *Near the ACHD Park and Ride/Meridian Speedway

*Pine Avenue, west of Main Street

*Pine Avenue, near Locust Grove [would need to be a partnership with the City as it is outside of the URD.

F. <u>Street Sign Toppers for Old Town:</u>

*Similar to what you see on Harrison Boulevard and other historic districts in Boise.

G. Partnership to restore McFadden Signage:

*Brian McClure suggested there may be a partnership opportunity with the Historical Commission to restore the original McFadden signage.
